

Scholarship Application Instructions for Student

1. Eligibility is limited to high school seniors who will be enrolled in an undergraduate college degree program during the 2017-2018 academic year.
2. Applicant or parent/guardian must be a member of the sponsoring credit union.
3. Each applicant must complete a current League scholarship application form and submit it with the other required material to the sponsoring credit union.
 - ◆ Students must submit a typewritten essay, In 250 words or less, about a person or event that has been an inspiration to you and how it has affected you and your outlook on life
 - ◆ An academic transcript of grades.
 - ◆ The member number of the applicant or parent/guardian must be on the application
4. Each scholarship application will be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - ◆ Essay
 - ◆ Grades
 - ◆ Extracurricular/community activities.
5. All items requested must be received in order for the application to qualify for consideration.

The deadline for submitting completed applications to Central One is Monday, February 27, 2017.

Any applications received after this date will not be considered.
